Now Joseph, who was also called Barnabas by the apostles (which translated means Son of Encouragement), owned a tract of land. So he sold it, and brought the money and laid it at the apostles' feet (Acts 4:36-37).

When Saul came to Jerusalem, he tried repeatedly to associate with the disciples; and yet they were all afraid of him, as they did not believe that he was a disciple. But Barnabas took hold of him and brought him to the apostles (Acts 9:26-27).

And Barnabas left for Tarsus to look for Saul; and when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. And for an entire year they met with the church and taught considerable numbers of people; and the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch (Acts 11:25-26).

As Paul and Barnabas were going out, the people repeatedly begged to have these things spoken to them the next Sabbath (Acts 13:42).

All the people kept silent, and they were listening to Barnabas and Paul as they were relating all the signs and wonders that God had done through them among the Gentiles (Acts 15:12).
