FOUR WAYS TO READ THE BIBLE

DEVOTIONAL INPUT

A disciplined quiet time in which you use the Bible to feed your own soul and to grow in your intimacy with God and His ways (i.e the Daily Bread)

CORE WORK

An on-going study of one or more Bible books (i.e. the book of Genesis, the Pentateuch, books of Luke, Pauline Epistles)

FAMILIARITY READING

A regular reading program through the whole Bible to become familiar with the Word (i.e. one- or multi-year Bible reading plan, Search the Scriptures)

SITUATIONAL STUDY

The study of a concentrated portion of the Bible, or some topic for personal reasons or direct use in a ministry setting (i.e. the Beatitudes, prayer, attributes of God)
